



## Carolyn Lajeunesse

June 12, 1932 - January 30, 2020

Carolyn (Jackson) Lajeunesse, 87, of 269 Ridgeview Estates, Harleysville, PA passed away on Thursday, January 30, 2020 at Peter Becker Community.

Born in Williamsport, PA on June 12, 1932 she was a daughter of the late Frederick and Harriet Jackson. Carolyn grew up immersed in the life of the Church of the Annunciation Parish where her father was sexton. She was a graduate of St. Joseph's High School and was Senior Prom Queen in 1950. As a young woman she served as the pianist at Annunciation Parish, and it was through this service that she met her beloved husband of 50+ years, Bill, who attended daily mass. They were married August 16, 1952 and lived in several locations in central Pennsylvania until settling in Chalfont in 1958. Together Carolyn and Bill provided a wonderful and loving home for their four children and forged a lifelong friendship with their neighbors, the Kowalicks, and were founding members of St. Jude Parish. Carolyn spent many years assisting Bill in the running of the family-owned Western Auto franchise, and later the Lansdale Bicycle Shop. In 1982 Carolyn started her career at Harriet Carter gifts where she worked in many different roles until her retirement in 1997. Carolyn and Bill moved to Macungie, PA in 1998 to spend their retirement years closer to many members of Carolyn's extended family. After Bill's death in 2005, Carolyn remained in Macungie developing a new network of wonderful friends. In 2017 Carolyn moved to the Peter Becker Community, in Harleysville, PA; here she received wonderful care for her increasing needs and once again Carolyn forged a new circle of wonderful friends. One of Carolyn's favorite annual rituals was to binge watch the NCAA College Basketball tournament; we know that she will be watching this year's March Madness tournament from above...

Surviving Carolyn are siblings: Elizabeth (Jackson- Braadt) DiMarco, Allentown, PA , James Jackson, West Palm Beach, FL, Fred Jackson, Slatington, PA. Children: daughter Carol Ann and her husband Robert Aubertin, of Telford, PA; sons Michael Lajeunesse and his wife Valorie, of West Palm Beach, FL; Bernard Lajeunesse and his wife Debra, of Chalfont, PA; and James Lajeunesse and his wife Jeannine, of Havertown, PA. Carolyn was blessed with fourteen grandchildren and sixteen great-grandchildren that were the

apple of her eye; she also adored her numerous nieces and nephews.

Preceding her in death (in addition to her parents) were her husband Bill, and two sisters Sr. Harriet Jackson, IHM and Betty Biichle.

A memorial service will be celebrated on Saturday, February 8, 2020 at 3:00pm in the chapel at Peter Becker Communities 800 Maple Ave, Harleysville, PA 19438. The family will receive guests and visitors from 2:00pm- 3:00pm before the service. A reception and meal will be held after the service in the community room across from the chapel.
